Prospective exhibits

Exhibition fees (including consumption tax) Charge for use of a booth:

¥108,000 for a booth for a single ISPC-supporting member who has paid the membership fee for 2019.

¥140,400 for a non-membership person or party.

Booth dimensions

- One booth: A frontage of 1.8 m/depth of 0.6 m/height of 2.4 m.
- Each booth is provided with a partition; a company name plate; one 40 W fluorescent lamp; an exhibition table; an electrical outlet (up to 500 W); ad one chair.

Maximum weight of exhibits

Up to 300 kg/m^2 for exhibits on the floor and 60 kg/m^2 for exhibits on a table.

Allotment of booths (please turn over)

As it is predicted that there will be many applications for poster sessions and exhibitions, booth allotment will be made taking into account the all aspects of applications such as the content of exhibits, their shape, the order of the receipt of applications and the layout of the exhibition hall, etc.
